EXTRA! EXTRA! READ (YOUR EMAIL) ALL ABOUT IT!

Lastly, just a bit of housekeeping from me. Many members have reported receiving only some Club email. We know that an increasing number of messages are hitting members' spam folders due to 1) certain keywords and phrases that are associated with spam, and 2) the sheer number of emails. I've asked our officers to review and try to reduce the number of emails we send, but here's how you can ensure our messages (like, "Inferno Registration is Open") get to you on time.

Please add the Club to your "Safe Sender" list or Whitelist for your email client. 99% of CHC emails come from the address vp@hellfire13.net so that's what you should enter as the sender.

For example, in Gmail (far and away the most popular choice for members) you would:

- 1. Click on the Gear icon (top right corner)
- 2. Click on "See All Settings" then "Filters and Blocked Addresses"
- 3. Click "Create a new filter"
 - a. Enter vp@hellfire13.net in the "From" field
 - b. Click Create Filter
 - c. Click the box for "Never send to Spam"
 - d. Click Create Filter again, and you're done!

For other email clients, you can find instructions by searching "[your email system name] safe sender list". Good instructions for creating a filter and ensuring that CHC email always reaches you are available.

Greetings, guests of the club!

Inferno is the annual run of the Chicago Hellfire Club. Imagine four whole days that are a lot like our monthly parties, six nights/seven days if you stay for both sessions. This is our 53rd Inferno and it will be an amazing time again!

You must be sponsored

CHC members must now submit the names and info of the men they will be sponsoring for Inferno 53. If you're interested in attending, be sure to chat with your sponsor. Guest must be sponsored each year, so be sure your sponsor knows you're interested, even if this will be a return trip for you. He'll need your legal name, email address, and physical address.

Inferno Applications

We strongly encourage you to read through these pages as they will answer many questions you might have. Like last year, the informational email packet for Inferno will be sent out the week before registration opens so that you have a chance to review all your options and talk with your guests. It will also give insight on how the registration process works so please remember to read it carefully.

If you have roommate preferences, start figuring that out now. Registration for Members will open on April 6th and Guests on April 20th. We expect Inferno to be popular and sell out again.

Change in Payment Policy

In an effort to streamline registration and reduce confusion with numerous options the Inferno Committee has set the only payment option to be 50%. Everyone pays 50% of their first selected housing option at time of registration. The remaining balance will appear as an invoice once confirmations go out and will be due prior to August 1st.

Change in Health Policy (formerly COVID-19 Vaccination Policy)

The Board of Directors and the Inferno Committee are no longer requiring proof of vaccination in order to attend Inferno. All attendees of CHC events are responsible for their personal health. Under the advice of your physician, you are encouraged to have all appropriate vaccinations and take personal precautions to prevent the spread of communicable diseases.





Birtles Scholarships

We don't ever want the cost to keep the right men from joining our event. The club maintains a scholarship fund to support a limited number of participants for whom it would otherwise be a financial hardship. Your sponsor may also submit you for a Birtles grant which will cover up to standard accommodation for one session and transportation.

Helping out at Inferno

If you're sponsored and register for Inferno, you'll have to do your part. All participants have a duty assignment. It's the only way we can make such an event work. Being selected to work Setup or Teardown counts as duty for one session of Inferno. That frees your time during the run for play. If you work both Setup and Teardown, you have the run entirely to yourself. Think about the options.

We are especially looking for men with skills in woodworking and carpentry for Setup, I encourage all to consider requesting the duty assignment.

If you are attending Session B, can you stay until the end on Thursday? The people who help us disassemble, stack the pile, reset the resort, and pack the truck prep the setup committee for Inferno 54.
